#### Re: Forest School at Framfield CEP School

Further to my letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> November 2016, I am writing to update you on our exciting Forest School initiative.

Thank you to all of you who have offered support in the creation and running of the Forest School, it is fantastic to have the involvement of our school community. We are planning for the necessary groundwork to be carried out within the next couple of weeks. It is our aim to start Forest School sessions in term 4.

I am delighted to inform you that the Forest School lessons will be led by Mrs Lydia Godfrey. Mrs Godfrey is a trained Forest School leader who has been responsible for the successful Forest school tuition at Blackboys School since 2014. Please find attached an information sheet from Mrs Godfrey, which gives details of what the children will be doing at Forest School and their associated benefits. Mrs Godfrey not only brings her expertise but she will also supply many of the necessary materials required for the sessions, is ropes, tarpaulin, tools. Mrs Godfrey will be delivering two sessions a week - on a Monday and Thursday morning. We are very grateful that our PTFA have generously agreed to fund one session per week and the other session will be funded by the school. We will issue a timetable soon to confirm when your child will have his/her sessions.

It is important that the children will be able to participate in Forest School, *whatever the weather*.  Forest School is an inspirational process that offers ALL learners regular opportunities to achieve and develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on learning experiences in a woodland or natural environment with trees. http://www.forestschoolassociation.org/what-is-forest-school/



We have a fantastic opportunity to develop a permanent site for our Forest School within the school grounds, extending to the patch of woodland beyond. Children will be able to gain a sense of ownership of this site and help manage it throughout the year. We will be working with natural materials and cultivating wildlife friendly planting.

My role as Forest School leader is to help implement the child-centric ethos of Forest School and encourage children to assess risk safely, gain independence and self-confidence. Our sessions will compliment classroom learning and, where possible, reiterate topic work.

Sessions include games then we could be doing simple woodwork, building a shelter or cooking on campfires and telling stories all around a theme from classwork. It always ends by sharing our thoughts on what we have done, enjoyed over a drink and a snack. Forest School lends itself to awakening senses. If children listen more, see more and feel more, they will learn more. Above all, it's fun!
