Write an article for a Mayan newspaper. Include topical stories set in the land of the ancient Mayan civilization. Don't forget to include Mayan gods and mythical creatures.	Make an information leaflet explaining aspects of the Mayan civilisation and culture. You could include sections on food, sport, religious rituals
Make a set of top trumps based on Mayan gods or animals.	Make a Mayan settlement using computer software such as Mine Craft.	Research Mayan gods. Make a power point presentation or poster illustrating various gods, their special powers and symbols.	Design a Mayan board game. Add facts, illustrations and don't forget the counters!
