<p><u>Numeracy</u> Mathletics work will be set every Thursday in line with the work we have been doing in class. Please ask in school for your Mathletics password if you're unsure.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u> The Romans had a special way of writing numbers. What information can you find out about Roman Numerals?</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u> Find the year when the Romans invaded Britain and then the year they left Britain. Work out how many years they ruled Great Britain. Show your working out.</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u> Once we have learnt about the Roman invasion of Britain, design and write a short newspaper article announcing the invasion.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Make a list of 10 (or more) adjectives and similes to describe a Roman Emperor.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Find some pictures of Celtic and Roman clothing. Design a poster discussing the differences between the two.</p>
<p><u>History/DT</u> An arch is much stronger than a rectangular opening in a wall (like a doorway). The most important stone in an arch is the keystone. If it slips the arch falls down. Find some examples of modern arches to draw. You could try building your own arches.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Find out about some of the amazing inventions the Romans created. Describe your favourite inventions in a page titled "Roman Science and Technology".</p>	<p><u>History</u> Can you find out the names of some Roman towns and cities and place them on a map of the UK?</p>
