Mathematical Development

We start this term by finishing off our work on multiplication and division. Following from that, we will spend a short time learning about measurement, before moving on to a longer focus on fractions. Although we are moving on from times them daily, therefore please continue to practise them frequently at home.

RE

In the first part of term, we will be trying to answer the question- How can a synagogue help us to understand the Jewish Faith? After half term, we will be learning about what it is like to follow God.
