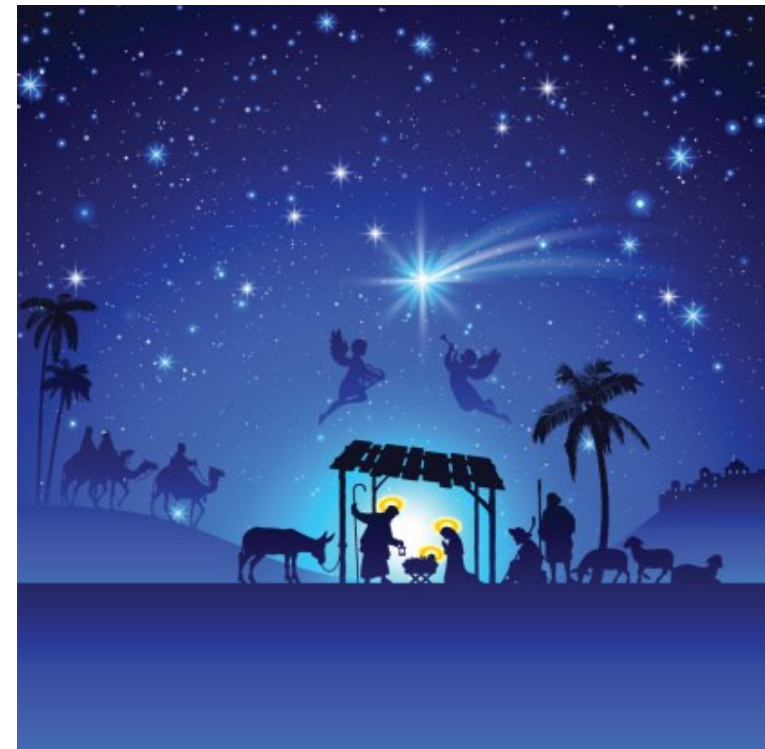
Due to personal circumstances Mrs Smith has resigned from her post as
