**Re: Peacocks trip to Blue Reef Aquarium, Hastings**

As a valuable addition to the work we are doing in class and linking in with our topic of 'Under The Sea,' this term we would like to take the children to the Blue Reef Aquarium in Hastings on Wednesday 06<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

In the morning we shall be exploring the Blue Reef Aquarium, being shown round by one of the Reef's specialist guides. They will be teaching the children about ocean pollution, coastal erosion and the habitats which under water creatures live within, as well as other interesting sea related facts.

During our time in Hastings we will also be visiting The Fisherman's Museum, where the children will be able to climb aboard a vessel which is located within the museum.

We are anticipating that the weather will be warm and to take advantage of this, and hope to eat our lunch on the beach, whilst also investigating the surrounding areas to the Aquarium and Fisherman's Museum. We shall also hopefully be taking the miniature train to experience a little steam travel!

We will be travelling by coach and leaving Framfield CEP School after registration at 8.55am approximately and returning for the end of the school day, 3.00pm. Your child will need the following:

- **Packed lunch with plenty of water placed in a bag that the children can carry.**
- **Children may wear own clothes but with a Framfield School jumper/cardigan.**
- **Your child must bring weather appropriate clothing. If the weather is warm, please can sun screen be applied to your child before you leave for school (we are unable to apply sunscreen), if wet a raincoat. Please can your child also bring with them a plastic bag (bin liner is ideal) to sit on at the beach.**
- **Comfortable but sturdy footwear as there may be uneven floors at the Fisherman's Museum.**

The cost of this trip will be £9.00. Grateful thanks must go to Framfield CEP School PTFA who are subsidizing the whole cost of the coach, without which we would be requiring £8.65 on top of the £9.00.
