Puffins Class Stone Age Trip, Ashdown Forest, 28th November 2018

Linking with our topic of the Stone Age, Puffins Class has the fantastic opportunity to visit Ashdown Forest, on **Wednesday**, **28**th **November 2018**. In the spirit of our Federation, Blackboys Class 3 will be joining Puffins class for the trip.

The pupils will be experiencing an interesting and topic related schedule of activities throughout the day, which will be run by the educational team at the Ashdown Forest centre. The objective of the day will be for the children to have learnt further about the skills and knowledge of Stone Age people; to have experienced first-hand the flora and fauna of the Ashdown Forest site; to learn and understand the importance of plants to Stone Age people's existence, as well as handling Stone Age artefacts that prove people hunted on the Ashdown Forest.

We shall be travelling to the Forest via coach, leaving Framfield CE School at 8.45 am, returning in time for the normal end of school day. **We will also be requiring two parental offers of assistance for the day**. Pupils can be dressed in their own clothes (weather dependent and warm) but a Framfield jumper should be worn. Plenty of drink and a packed lunch will need to be brought along.
