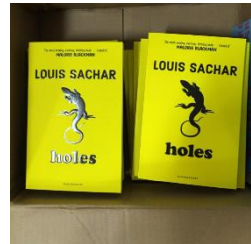

Reading

Reading is a real focus for Framfield School this year. We want to make changes so that even more children enjoy reading and make even better progress so that they become fluent, accurate readers with a good understanding of the books that they meet. This week, the school council devised a reading questionnaire which all children completed in their house group assemblies. We now begin the job of collating the results.

The PTFA have kindly set aside money for reading resources this week and we were pleased to take delivery of the 'key Autumn texts' this week. Previously, pupils could only listen to the teacher read the book and look at copied sections of the text. Having direct access to the books will really support reading comprehension.
