<p>Peacocks Reception</p> <p>Homework set on Friday and should be returned by Tuesday.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading a minimum of 5 x a week (15 mins) reading their class reading book and being read too. To be recorded in their reading record.• One task set by Mrs Kent related to the learning for that week. This will be in their homework book.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mathematics. Children will have access to all of the maths relating to the Early Learning Goals. More challenging activities may be set by the class teacher when appropriate.
<p>Kingfishers Year 1 and 2</p> <p>Homework set on Thursday and should be returned by Tuesday of the following week.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading a minimum of 5 x a week (15 mins) reading their class reading book and being read too. To be recorded in their reading record.• Maths task set by the class teacher in their homework book (mental maths, number bonds).• Mental Maths practice daily 5 minutes (see Key Instant Recall Facts in Homework books).• Spellings practice, Look Cover Write Check sheet (5-10 minutes several times a week) Please test your child.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spelling shed activities which are set by the class teacher. They may need adult support.• Mathematics- tasks are set for the maths topic currently being worked on in class.• Homework menu. At least one a term but we would encourage more and efforts will be recognised and rewarded.
<p>Puffins Year 3 and 4</p> <p>Homework set on Wednesday and should be returned by Monday of the following week.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading a minimum of 3 x a week (20 mins) reading their class reading book to an adult. To be recorded in their reading record. Children to record written responses to questions in their reading records.• Maths task set by the class teacher in their homework book (mental maths, times tables).• Spellings practise, Look Cover Write Check sheet (5-10 minutes several times a week) Please test your child.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spelling shed activities on line.• Spelling shed 'spice up your spellings' spelling activities (may need some adult support)• Homework menu. At least one a term but we would encourage more and efforts will be recognised and rewarded.
<p>Eagles Year 5 and 6</p> <p>Homework set on Monday and should be returned by the following Monday.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading a minimum of 3 x a week (20 mins) reading their class reading book to an adult. To be recorded in their reading record. Children to record written responses to questions in their reading records. Adults to sign once a week.• Spellings 'Look Cover Write Check', please test your child and ensure more practise if required.• Mathematics – a task to be set each week on line.• GCP book tasks set for year 6 (Wk 1 Number and grammar task Wk 2 Reading and grammar task)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read theory• Spelling shed on line activities• Home learning tasks for grid- at least one quality piece of work per term (i.e. 6 pieces per year).
