Teaching and Learning

The children have made a really good start back to school and I am pleased to see them engaged and focused in their lessons. As a staff team, we are always reviewing our practice, looking within and beyond our Federation to consider how we can support our children's learning in the best ways possible. As pupils progress through the school, we want them to develop as writers and a key skill is the ability to edit and revise their own work. To that end, the staff have worked together to create an 'Editing and Revising Ladder'. This illustrates which aspects of writing we expect children to be able to improve. The expectations build across the school until in Year 6, the children can then confidently and independently improve the quality of their own writing.
