Lions ROAR 2020

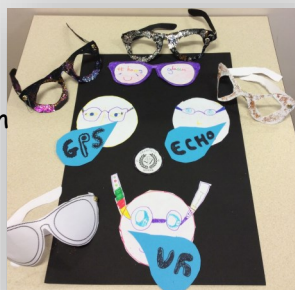

Lions ROAR 2020 is an ideas competition for primary schools created by Lions Clubs International and run by 7billionideas, the award winning education company. It aims to unlock the creative spirit in every child by giving them the time to imagine and develop ideas that could change the world!

The competition is for Key Stage 2 students of Primary Schools up to the age of 10/11 as well as pupils at Special Needs Schools up to the age of 11/12. The purpose is to encourage and develop the creativity existing in all young people. The objective is to generate and develop an IDEA that could change the World. It could be about absolutely anything as long as it has a positive impact on the planet.

In Eagles Class, the children worked in small groups to come up with their idea, they pitched their idea to all of the teachers in the school and one group were chosen to represent the school. In previous year, pupils have then pitched against all of the competing schools in the South East area. Once again, our children came up with a host of original and inventive ideas. This year the children's pitch is videoed and sent in for the finals. Sophia, Bella and Georgia are representing Framfield this year and you can view their video from the school website. Their product called 'Happy Glasses' is aimed at supporting people suffering from dementia and loneliness. The glasses use VR, GPS and voice recognition to help the wearer know where they are, and recognise people they meet.

Over the last two year, Framfield has come second place overall when competing against between 15 and 20 schools. We wish our Team lots of luck this year.

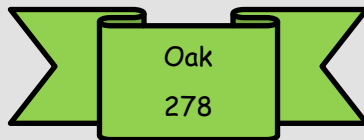

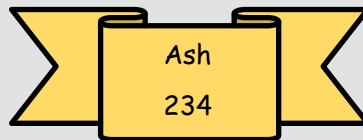
