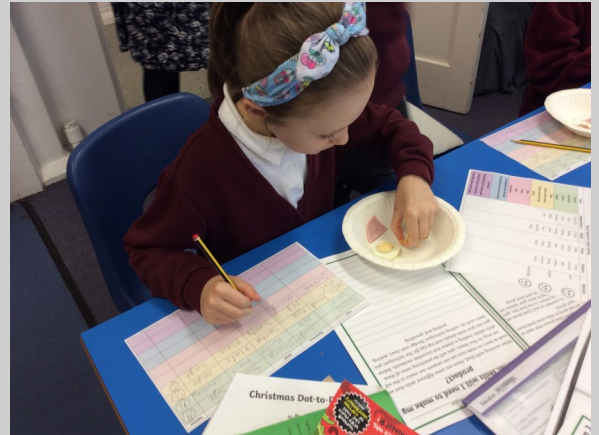
Talk and Tea Inclusion Support Group

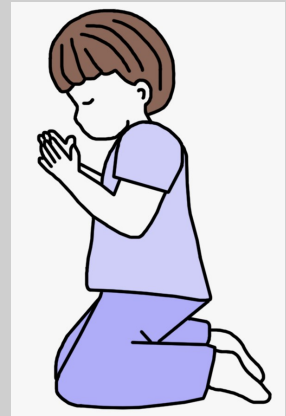
Learning About Food
