A small number of year 4, 5 and 6 pupils took part in the Primary Maths Challenge on Wednesday. This is the first time Framfield School has taken part in this nationwide Maths competition and they were ably supported by our Federation Maths leader Mr Boorman. The challenge gave the children the chance to use their mathematical reasoning and logical thinking skills to solve a series of seriously tough problems. Certificates will be awarded to all pupils taking part, with a prize for the child with the highest score in the challenge.

Children in Need - Crazy Catwalk- Friday 18th November

The school council have come up with a fantastic idea to raise money for Children in Need this year. Pupils are able to enter into a Children in Need 'Crazy Catwalk'!

Children who would like to take part will pay £1 entry fee and give their names to their class teachers on Friday morning. They will need to bring with them their crazy catwalk outfit in a bag to get changed into after lunch. The whole school will then watch the 'Crazy



Catwalkers' strut their stuff in the Memorial Hall in the afternoon. We will have a little catwalk marked out for the children, one at a time, to walk down to show off their crazy outfits. School council members will be judges and there will be a small prize for the "Craziest" KS1 and KS2 entries, plus a little lolly for everyone who takes part. There's a rumour that some members of staff are keen to take part too!


