In the event of extreme weather warnings being issued by ESCC, ties will be able to be removed. We will notify Parents via the ParentMail service.

Long hair should always be tied back using a hairband. Hair accessories should be small and discrete, fit for the purpose of holding hair, not for decoration. Plain/neutral colours or Framfield Maroon would be best.

Maroon Fleeces are available to buy and can be used as a coat. In the case of extreme cold weather, children may wear a maroon fleece in class in addition (not instead of) their school jumper.

Shoes should be black lace ups or Velcro fastenings, with low heels. They must be of traditional School style, not black trainers, sneaker style or plimsolls.

Boots are prohibited.

In Peacocks, only book bags are used. These can be purchased from our uniform providers website. All children will require a book bag to carry letters/homework/reading books. Children will also need a drawstring PE Bag. As children get older they are invited to use a rucksack of their choice.

We ask that the following points are observed:

- Parents not to send pupils to school in unsuitable footwear including no fluorescent or decorative socks or shoes.
- For health, hygiene and developmental reasons, the wearing of trainers or boots all day is not permitted.
- Children must change for PE.
- With the exception of a traditional watch or 'fitbit' being worn, children may not wear jewellery to school.
 Only small plain 'sleeper studs' may be worn with pierced ears. All earnings should be removed or covered with micropore tape during PE sessions. Watches will also be removed for PE lessons.
- For Safety reasons; long hair should be tied back at all times. Hair bands, if worn, must be plain, discrete
 and preferably of the school colour (maroon). Excessively large or colorful hairbands are not permitted.
 The use of excessive hair gel to create elaborate hair styles is not permitted.
- Wearing of make-up or nail varnish is not permitted.

All items should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.
