There is lots of work going on behind the scenes to make the school the best that it can be. Hopefully some of these projects will be evident soon.



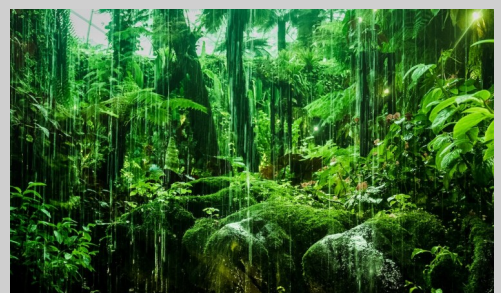
Perfect Pantomime
