Thank you to Mrs Kent who puts so much effort into all of our sporting events and encouraging the children to try lots of new activities.

Mathletics

Due to rising subscription costs and negligible usage/uptake, we have made the difficult decision to reduce our Mathletics subscription; we were paying £1200 per year for many licenses that were not being used regularly. We now hold 20 Mathletics licenses; using data from the site we have worked out that 14 children use the site regularly and we have purchased 6 additional licenses on top of this. Should your child be a very keen Mathletics user, or is seriously keen to become one, please email your class teacher to reserve one of these licenses so that your child can continue on their Mathletics journey. We will then check whether they are someone who regularly used the site previously.

We want our children in Year R- 2 to focus on using 'Numbots' which focuses on the key skills to be confident with numbers. If the children can perfect their understanding and speed in these age appropriate areas then that will be hugely beneficial to supplement their learning. We want the children in KS2 to focus on TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) for their speed recall of times tables.

E-Safety

Well done to Elena and Suki for their superb E-Safety Poster. Their extra effort and artistic skills have earned them a Headteacher's award. We will upload a copy of their poster to the school website soon.

Question answered

A few parents have asked about why we have children from Eagles class greeting on the playground in the mornings.
