### D-Day

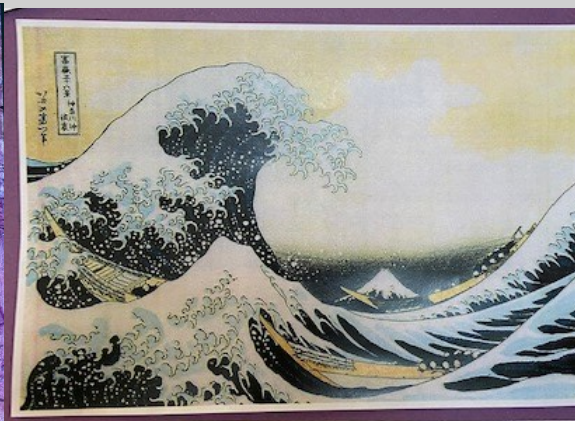

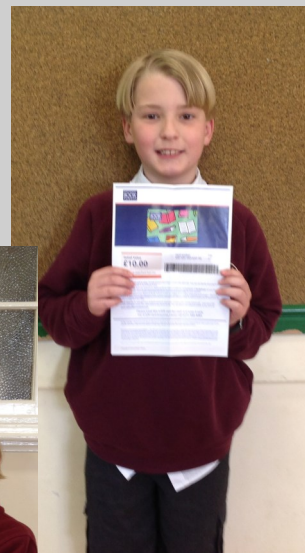
We need people from 10am through to 6pm, so you could even give us 90 minutes before or after the event, leaving you free to enjoy the afternoon.
