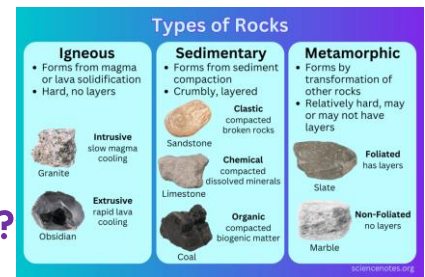





Puffin Class Term 3 Newsletter **'What makes rocks beautiful?'**

COMPULSORY	Reading 	<p>Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure their reading is logged on Boom Reader, a quick and easy process – I've sent home your individual login and simple guide on how to download the app today.</p> <p>I will check Boom Reader every Friday and give rewards to the children who have completed 3 reads. If you still wish to record your child's reads in their yellow Reading Record, please do so, but I will be moving away from this method at the end of this term.</p>
	Lexia 	<p>Lexia is now part of our weekly routine in school. To support us with this valuable reading tool, please can children practise at home for 20 minutes per week. I have sent your child's login home today.</p>
	Times Tables 	<p>Every child has a Times Table Rock Stars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week, ready for our weekly 'Club 99' tests. It is crucial that the children practise at home to support their maths in school, which relies heavily on recall of multiplication and division facts. I have sent home login reminders today.</p>
OPTIONAL	CGP Books	<p>I will continue to send home a new task each Friday for Maths and Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling, and will collect CGP books/folders the following Friday as normal.</p>
