This term, we are starting a new geography topic based around 'What makes a hospitable environment?'. We will be using 'Wolf Brother' by Michelle Paver, and 'Holes' by Louis Sachar, as inspiration in our writing. Our focus in Geography moves from Europe, across the Atlantic to learn about North America and in R.E. we will be learning more about Hinduism. In Maths, we will be finishing off fractions before moving onto looking at decimals and then area, perimeter and volume.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home. All children in the class have a Lexia account and will be able to log-on to this at home to complete tasks.				
Maths and Grammar	Maths and Grammar homework will be set on a Monday and will be due fortnightly. The homework will be marked in school and brought home again. A record will be kept of those bringing their books in regularly to be marked.				
Times Tables	Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.
