

Introduction

At Framfield CE Primary School, we believe that wearing a school uniform is important in ensuring high standards and a sense of pride and belonging to the school. Our policy is that all children within the school pupils should wear clothing that is in keeping with a purposeful learning ethos. The Governors and staff support the wearing of this uniform.

Our policy is based on the belief that a school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- engenders a feeling of belonging
- is practical and distinctive
- identifies the children with the school
- makes children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance
- reflects the sense of community that the school takes pride in.

Expectations

- There is a formal school uniform to which children are expected to adhere, and the co-operation of parents in maintaining the standard of dress is expected.
- Uniform items which do not require the school logo can be purchased from elsewhere providing they meet the school's requirements.
- We reserve the right to forbid items of clothing, accessories and footwear that are not on the school uniform list; are unacceptably dangerous in school or against the interests of the children at large.
- Only wristwatches and stud earrings are permitted and hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back. Earrings are to be covered or removed for P.E. sessions. On health and safety grounds, no other jewellery is to be worn at school.
- 'Extreme haircuts' as well as 'brightly coloured' or dyed 'fluorescent' hair is **NOT** permitted. The expectation is for children's hair to be of a natural colour.
- If pupils attend school wearing inappropriate uniform or hair style/colour, the procedure will be for the child to borrow and wear spare uniform. They will return these items when they leave the school premises at the end of the day. A Framfield CE Primary School cap will be borrowed and worn during the school day to prevent exposure of inappropriate hair colour/style until the situation has been resolved.
- Washable transfers or tattoos are also not permitted.
- Nail varnish/fake nails should not be worn to school.
- All sweatshirts/cardigans **must** have the school logo on them.

Uniform

The expectation of all children is that they wear the correct school uniform, which is appropriate for the weather. In the event of extreme weather warnings being issued by ESCC, ties will be able to be removed. We will notify parents/carers via the ParentMail service.

Autumn/Spring:

Grey trousers or shorts, white polo shirt, maroon school sweater/jumper, grey/black socks.

Year 5/6 -A white shirt and school tie, maroon school v neck sweater/jumper.

Grey skirt, grey pinafore dress or plain grey school trousers, white polo shirt, white socks and maroon school sweater or cardigan, charcoal grey or black tights.

Year 5/6 -A white shirt/blouse and tie, maroon school v neck sweater/cardigan.

Summer:

Grey trousers or shorts, white polo shirt, maroon school sweater/jumper, grey/black socks.

Year 5/6 -A white shirt and school tie, maroon school v neck sweater/jumper

Maroon/pink gingham dress or grey skirt with white polo shirt and white socks.

Year 5/6 -A white shirt/blouse and tie, maroon school v neck sweater/cardigan.

Fleeces are available in school colours and provide a very useful addition on cool days.

PE Kit:

Black shorts (or plain grey or black jogging bottoms/leggings **in winter**), white T Shirt, socks and black plimsolls/plain trainers. Children in Years 3/4/5/6 may wear plain trainers for outdoor games.

Swimming Kit (Year 3/4 ONLY): trunks and towel OR one piece swimming costume and towel.

Hair Style:

For health and safety reasons, please tie long hair back using a hairband. Hair accessories should be small and discrete, fit for the purpose of holding hair, not for decoration. Plain/neutral colours or 'Framfield maroon' colour would be best.

We request that haircuts do not follow fashion as this causes a distraction. 'Extreme haircuts' as well as 'brightly coloured' or dyed 'fluorescent' hair is NOT permitted. The expectation is for children's hair to be of a natural colour.

Jewellery:

We recommend earrings are not worn to school. A watch may be worn but will need to be removed for PE.

Nails / Make-Up:

Nails varnish / fake nails or make-up (including lip gloss) should not be worn to school.

Shoes:

Shoes should be black lace ups or Velcro fastenings, with low heels. Sandals may be worn in the summer but should not have open toes.

All children will require a bag to carry letters/homework/reading books.
