Home Learning

COMPULSORY	Reading 	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure their reading is logged on Boom Reader. I will check Boom Reader every Friday and move children who have completed 3 reads onto the next stage of our Reading Challenge. Children who get to the end of the challenge receive a prize!
	Times Tables 	Every child has a Times Table Rock Stars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week , ready for our regular 'Club 99' tests and, for the Year 4s, the Multiplication Tables Check this term. It is crucial that the children practise at home to support their maths in school, which relies heavily on recall of multiplication and division facts.
OPTIONAL	Lexia 	To support us with this valuable reading tool, please can children practise at home for 20 minutes per week .
	CGP Books	I will continue to send home new tasks each Friday for Maths and Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling, and will collect CGP books/folders the following Friday as normal. For Year 4s, Maths tasks may be in books or on separate sheets, depending on the topic area.

Questions you could ask your child about their learning this term:

- What happened during the Stone Age?
- What happened during the Iron Age?
- Who were hunter gatherers?
- How was Britain different back in the Stone or Iron Age?




















